STRATEGIC ROADMAP: FROM BOARDS TO JEE APRIL

PHASE 1: THE DUAL-TRACK BALANCE (Now - Mar 9)

Confidence in Boards?
70% JEE | 30% Boards

Weak in Boards?
80% Boards | 20% JEE (High-Weightage)

THE 10-YEAR PYQ RULE for Boards

Focus exclusively on last 10 years of CBSE PYQs. Practice definitions, derivations, & descriptive presentation for 75%+.

INTEGRATION: Use Board Prep for Theoretical Foundation. For Chem, focus on NCERT-based theory (Vital for Both!).

PHASE 2: THE JEE APRIL SPRINT (Mar 10 - Apr 2)



REPAIR THE "DAMAGED PARTS"

Identify skipped/failed chapters. Watch specific lectures & update notes for these topics ONLY.

PYQs as the Key to Success

1. PRIORITIZE: Every Jan 2024 Shift Paper.
2. FOLLOWED BY: 2023 & 2022 JEE Main Pools.

TIME-BOUND PRACTICE

Stop casual solving. ALWAYS use a clock to increase speed & prevent getting stuck on single problems.

CRITICAL BLUNDERS TO AVOID

- ✗ DON'T START FROM ZERO: Avoid the "fresh start" trap. Build on existing knowledge, don't re-watch basics.
- ✗ AVOID "NEW SOURCE" ATTRACTION: Stick to original coaching notes/trusted PDFs (e.g., Manzil). Switching causes confusion & wastes time.
- ✗ ACTION OVER MOTIVATION: Minimize strategy/motivational videos. 3 hours of mock testing > any "secret" tip.
